

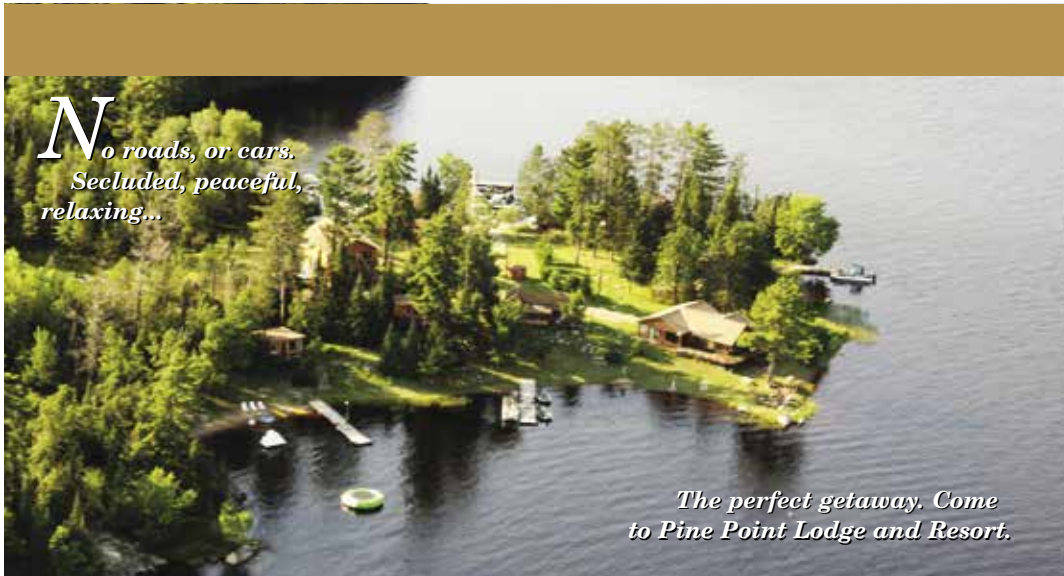

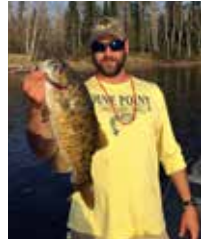

Mukooda Lake

This lake is about 5 miles from the Lodge by boat, and lies within Voyageur National Park; one of our nation's finest! The hike to Mukooda is relatively easy, less than a block long. We have one boat on Mukooda Lake so plan early. The lake is known for its small and largemouth bass, lake trout and abundant panfish. This is an action packed fishing lake for youngsters and adults alike. Mukooda is a clear, spring-fed lake with a clarity of approximately 20'.

Whether you're fishing, hiking, or just relaxing you will cherish this lake's tranquility and beauty. There is a picnic area located on the lake.

So pack a shore lunch and a camera; then head out to Mukooda for the perfect remote lake experience!!

LAKES AND RIVERS

Crane Lake

Only one mile from the end of the road gives Pine Point the quiet getaway location that you will cherish each time you visit. Being strategically located at your back door, the BWCAW, Voyageurs National Park, and Canada's Quetico Provincial Park offer you unspoiled wilderness with millions of acres and thousands of scenic shoreline miles to fish, hike, and explore.

From Crane Lake you can travel over 120 miles by boat. Crane Lake has many natural fishing areas. On either side of Pine Point's Peninsula, there are two separate rivers coming in. Walleyes, bass and crappies key on the forage that is abundant in these incoming waters.

Loon Lake

One of the most scenic trips to take. Voyage down the Loon River to a mechanical portage that allows you to cross into Loon Lake.

The walleye, northern pike and smallmouth bass fishing are spectacular in these majestic waters. Fish either the American or Canadian side.

The distance from the Lodge is approximately 20 miles. Caution is to be used when traveling to Loon Lake. For your first trip a guide would be recommended. Anticipate seeing a majestic bull moose, black bear, playful otters or other mystifying wildlife. Don't forget your camera for this trip!!

Vermilion River – River fishing at its best! Our 14' boat is nestled below the falls on the Vermilion River. This allows you to fish the area from the Vermilion Falls down to the Rapids above the Gorge at Crane Lake.

Note: Very little fishing pressure is on this area. We have maps that you can review to help you become familiar with this exclusive fishing area.

Walleyes, crappies and bass swim in the strong currents of this secret fishing hole. The 300-yard portage is a very scenic wilderness trail.

Sharpen up your river fishing skills on the Vermilion River. Get ready to reel them in!

Discounted Catch and Release Program

allows you to harvest fish. However, in order to maintain your fishing satisfaction and to preserve our fishery, the larger, spawning fish must be released. The complete group must participate to qualify for these discounted rates. Guidelines below:

Walleye	17" and over
Crappie	12" and over
All Bass.....	14" and over
Northern Pike	26" and over
Muskellunge.....	All sizes
Lake Trout.....	25" and over

LAKES AND RIVERS

Vermilion Gorge

Hike the Historic Gorge... track wildlife... listen to loons... watch eagles.

One of the most picturesque areas of Crane Lake is the Vermilion Gorge. The trail can be picked up just around the point from the Lodge.

The 3 mile Vermilion Gorge Trail, at a leisurely pace, can be easily hiked in 3 hours. The last portion of the trail parallels the Gorge – a rugged landscape of sheer granite cliffs and rock outcrops. As you begin this portion of the trail, notice the change in vegetation. The ground is covered with a soft, green moss carpet sprinkled with spearmint plants to enhance the beauty of this majestic, scenic wonder.

A breathtaking adventure you must experience.

Visit the Vermilion Falls... marvel at the cascading waterfall...



A 10-minute hike on a well-maintained trail going southwest puts you at the Vermilion Falls, a cascading torrent of water forced through a 10-foot-wide opening in the granite.

The northeast section of the trail will lead you to “The Chute,” a constriction in the river that produces a Class III to V rapids. This is a pleasant 5-minute walk and worth the effort.

Look for wild rice beds. The shoots begin to emerge in mid-July and seed heads won't develop until the first part of August. Extensive wild rice beds flourish along the Vermilion River and are harvested by humans and wildlife alike from late August through October.

There are picnic tables and fire grates at the site for a perfect afternoon adventure!



Of the park's 218,000 acres over one-third are water. Thirty lakes of all sizes make up this enchanting chain of lakes. The larger lakes are dotted with pine covered rocky islands. The beauty is extraordinary. Your experience at Pine

Point could include motorboating, fishing, canoeing, sightseeing, hiking along trails – looking for animal signs or blueberries in season. Voyageurs National Park stands preserved and protected by the National Park Service, giving you a view of the world as it appeared to the French and Canadian fur traders centuries ago.

Aspen: Located on our sandy beach, enjoy an undisturbed night of rest in either private bedroom. Each has your choice of a comfortable king bed and two twin beds. The lake view living room has a queen sized memory foam sofa sleeper. This beautiful knotty pine cabin's spacious deck is only 60' from the water's edge and your dock. Sleeps up to 6.



Whitepine: Find a restful night's sleep in either bedroom. One has a king bed or two twin beds. The other has a double extra-long bed and set of unique wooden bunk beds. The relaxing living room has a queen sized memory foam sofa bed. Whitepine is next to the sand beach and the large deck is 52' from the shore and your dock. Sleeps up to 8.

Balsam: From the roomy deck, a breathtaking view, only 79' from the water's edge and your dock. Revive yourself from a good night's rest on a comfortable extra-long double bed and set of bunk beds in one bedroom, or choose the other bedroom with either a king bed or two twin beds. A queen sized memory foam sofa sleeper is located in the living room overlooking the lake. Sleeps up to 7.

Bayview: Facing south, this knotty pine interior cottage with a large covered deck is 60' from the shoreline. Wake up refreshed after sleeping on your choice of a comfortable king bed or two twin beds that each private bedroom provides. Enjoy the living room which overlooks the lake, a queen sized memory foam sofa sleeper and twin bed for additional guests. Air conditioned. Sleeps up to 7.

Oak: The large deck is only 36' from the water's edge and your dock. Enjoy a contented nights rest in either bedroom. One has a comfortable extra-long double bed and a set of sturdy bunk beds. The other has a king size bed or two twin beds. A sleeper sofa is provided in the living room. Sleeps up to 7.

Spruce: Pamper yourself on either a king size bed or two twins in one bedroom, or a comfortable, extra-long double bed and set of unique log bunks in the other bedroom. There is additional sleeping available on the sofa bed or extra-long twin bed in the living room. Spruce's dock is only 29' from the deck and doorstep. Sleeps up to 7.

Norway: This cottage is located on a picturesque rock ridge that overlooks Crane Lake. Sitting on the deck, you are only 26' from the water's edge. Sleep peacefully in either bedroom. Each has your choice of a king bed or twin beds. If you choose, snuggle into the sofa sleeper in the living room and watch the stars through the sliding glass door. Sleeps up to 6.

Birch: This spacious cottage is great for large groups. With a knotty pine interior, each bedroom is equipped with restful, relaxing, comfortable beds. Two of the bedrooms each have a king size bed or two twin size beds, the other bedroom has two sets of bunk beds. The cottage is located only 26' from the water's edge and dock slips. Sleeps up to 8.

Poplar: Nestled back in the woods for more privacy, and an undisturbed night of rest. Poplar has a knotty pine interior and your choice of a comfortable king bed or two twin beds in one bedroom and an extra-long double bed with a twin on top in the other. The living room has a sofa bed. The water's edge is only 71' away from your roomy wrap-around deck. Sleeps up to 6.

Experience your unique cottage floating on the water. At night fall asleep to the gentle rocking of the boat, wake up the next morning to the sound of ducks and the call of the loon. An elegant modern design, luxurious with custom kitchen cabinets and large windows all around. Our 46' houseboat has two double bed staterooms, a spacious living room with sofa sleeper, galley equipped with a full size stove, refrigerator/freezer, microwave, toaster, Bunn coffee maker, all cook and dishware. The boat is ideally located on the north end of our peninsula which provides picturesque views from every room and from the upper deck from breakfast to a sunset dinner. Private, yet accessible to the marina and in close proximity to the main lodge. Complete with a water slide from the upper deck into the water and excellent fishing right off the back of the boat. A CTIVITIES

SHOPPING - Unique souvenir shops are nearby as well. Take a day trip shopping adventure. We have a shopping route and map to take.

HIKING TRAILS - Hike into the pristine wilderness on one of our many scenic trails. Maps and trail information available at the Lodge.

SANDY SWIMMING BEACH, playground, horseshoes, and basketball, are a few of the activities available at the resort. Bring your snorkel equipment & head to the astounding Mukooda Lake. Swim amongst the bass and other fish as you explore this phenomenal lake.

HISTORIC SITES - Voyage to Kettle Falls, visit Dillinger's hideout cottage, see where the Burasa Fur Trading Post was while traveling the many routes of the early Voyageurs.



GOLF - 9-hole golf course only 9 miles away on the scenic Vermilion. Additional golf courses are listed on our website.

SCENIC DAY TRIPS - Take a trip to Lac La Croix, visit the BWCAW, Voyageurs National Park, see some of nature's oldest exposed glacial rock formations, high rock cliffs, find your own private sand beach, tour the Canadian Waters, the exploring is endless.

RESTAURANTS - THE AMERICAN PLAN ALTERNATIVE: Tired of having to be at breakfast at a given time, or the fish are biting, but you have to get back to camp to eat supper? Try this alternative: Each cottage has cooking facilities in them. If you want to cook your own meal, you can. If you want your meals prepared, pick one of the local restaurants to eat at. Their hours are generally, 6:30 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. You pick the time you want to eat, and go. If you would like a courtesy shuttle by Pine Point to any of the restaurants, let us know. All restaurants are a short 5 minutes away by boat.

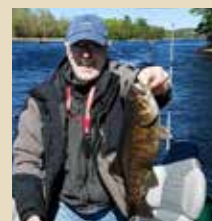

TRAVEL TIPS

To reach Pine Point, take Hwy. 53 North to Orr, MN. Crane Lake is approximately 28 miles from Orr. Turn east (right) at the stop light in Orr onto County Road 23 which becomes County Road 24 at Buyck, MN. Follow the road to Crane Lake. There will be a sharp curve going right, and then you will cross a bridge. From the bridge, drive approximately one block, our sign is on the roadside. You may call us from your cell phone if you have service or from the pay phone. There is no charge for parking or boat launching.

PRIVATE AIRCRAFT:

Orr, MN, 25 miles from Crane Lake. A 4,000 ft. paved strip, 24-hour service and car rental. Floatplanes can fly directly to Pine Point. Feel free to contact us for transportation.

COMMERCIAL FLIGHT:

Commercial service available to Hibbing or Int'l Falls (both 70 mi. to Crane Lake), and Duluth (130 mi. to Crane Lake). Car rentals are available at all locations or ask us about airport transportation to Pine Point.
